or participating in a clinical trial.

• Warrior to Warrior Patch Program (Global) •

A meaningful "give a patch, take a patch, send a patch" initiative honoring both military service members and young cancer warriors uniting two communities through shared strength and support.

• Patch Support "Retention" Program (Global) •

An industry-funded program providing personalized patch-based encouragement to children and teens participating in any pediatric clinical trial.

• Sprinkle Room •

A creative arts community space designed for immunocompromised pediatric patients and their families. This clean, safe environment fosters creativity, connection, and joy.
